Yearly, the SMSA is confronted with many unfortunate challenges of negative coaching issues. Often times, problems with coaches go unnoticed by club officials or are simply a part of the club "rumor mill". Many times parents and players are reluctant to approach club officials and/or their coach about problems, for fear of a possible negative impact on the player. It is our goal to meet with coaching problems early on to improve the situation quickly and grow from the problem. The coach **CAN** grow and improve in most situations if dealt with early on. This evaluation process will serve to help improve this situation.

On a positive note, we also want to promote this evaluation to recognize the **GOOD** our coaches do as well. Often the good is lost with the bad and soccer is not immune to this problem.

We are striving for 100% compliance on this matter. Improved communication will be the key to improved coaches and team relations. The scores from these evaluations will be reviewed when coaches are being considered for re-selection for the following year. Please give this matter the same priority our coaches give to coaching you children, throughout the year. Please know, that your individual evaluation will be held **CONFIDENTIAL** and only be used to create a summary to be presented to the coaches.
